THE NIGHTMARE BEFORE CHRISTMAS (PG)

When Jack accidentally stumbles on Christmastown, all bright colors and warm spirits, he gets a new lease on life — he plots to bring Christmas under his control by kidnapping Santa Claus and taking over the role. But Jack soon discovers even the best-laid plans of mice and skeleton men can go seriously awry.



DIE HARD (15)

THE MUPPET CHRISTMAS CAROL (U)

They show him the error of his self-serving ways, but the miserable old man seems to be past any hope of redemption and happiness.

NEVER LOOK AWAY (15)

Never Look Away follows the extraordinary and entirely true story of Margaret Moth, an award-winning journalist who risked her life countless times to capture history's most catastrophic events on film. From her first assignment covering the riots after Gandhi's assassination to reporting from the frontlines of the Persian Gulf War, the Bosnian War, and the Lebanon War, Moth's fearless pursuit of the truth made her a legend in the world of journalism.



THE LAST DANCE (12A) Japanese with English subtitles

Despite the pandemic sending most industries into recession, debt-ridden wedding planner Dominic (Dayo WONG) gets a miraculous chance to turn things around when a funeral planner retires and passes the baton to him. His creative gimmicks for funerals help his business find unexpected success, but Dominic's biggest obstacle is winning the approval of respected and sternly traditional Taoist priest, Master Man.

New York City newspaper writer J.J. Hunsecker (Burt Lancaster) holds considerable sway over public opinion with his Broadway column, but one thing that he can't control is his younger sister, Susan (Susan Harrison), who is in a relationship with aspiring jazz guitarist Steve Dallas (Marty Milner).
